

30-Day Lawn/Landscape Irrigation Permit Application

Please take note:

- If it ever becomes necessary to temporarily ban automated irrigation for any reason, 30-day permits may be nullified without notice. No new permits will be issued after the declaration of Stage 3 or Stage 4 water advisories.
- Permits are valid for 30 days and will allow daily watering, as determined by landscape or irrigation contractor or as recommended by the NC Cooperative Extension Service, to establish new seed, sod, plugs, or commercial landscaping.
- Spraying impervious surfaces and/or malfunctioning systems is strictly prohibited.
- Approved projects must have issued permit signage clearly posted on property.
- Customers will receive a reminder via e-mail or telephone three (3) days prior to the end of the exception period. Upon expiration of the permit customers must resume watering schedule in effect.
- · All current water/sewer rates apply as usual to the water consumed during the exception period.
- Requests may take up to 3 business days to be reviewed and processed. You will be notified
 if/when application is approved. Permit signs must be picked up within 3 business days or
 application will be void.
